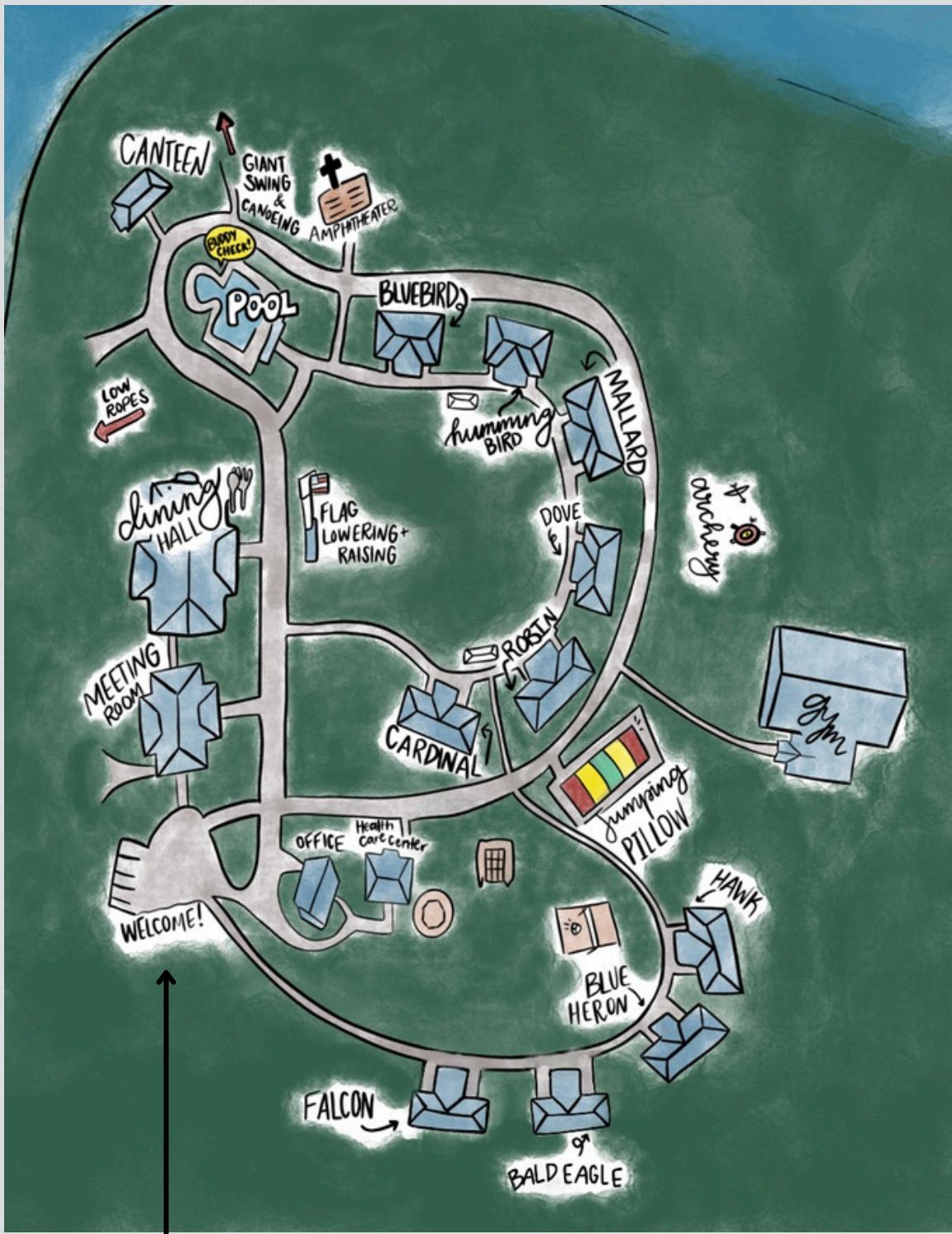
*We will do our best to make sure that you are with others from your campus! You can indicate rooming preferences on your registration.
