CHECK-IN

You will receive a QR code in the email used for registration within two days of the event. When you arrive to our Capital Hills campus, volunteers will scan your code and direct you inside. (Don't worry-- if you don't see a QR code, we can use your name for check-in.)

You will take your student to the auditorium where they will meet their small group leader(s). We will have signs and volunteers to help you! From there, you can exit the same way you entered.

CHECK-OUT

Students will be finishing their last session just prior to checkout. Please go to the auditorium at the end of the session to find your student(s) prior to the cookout.

Small Groups

All small groups will be grade/gender/campus-based, and will be led by one of our small group leaders. Our hope is to have no more than eight students per small group.

Small Group Leaders

All small group leaders will submit a background check (if not already on file). Small group leaders are usually the same leaders that your student sees each weekend.
