What was from the <u>beginning</u>, what we have heard, what we have seen with our <u>eyes</u>, what we have observed and have <u>touched</u> with our hands, concerning the word of life—that <u>life</u> was revealed, and we have seen it and we testify and declare to you the <u>eternal</u> life that was with the Father and was revealed to us—what we have seen and heard we also <u>declare</u> to you, so that you may also have <u>fellowship</u> with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the <u>Father</u> and with his Son, <u>Jesus</u> Christ. We are writing these things so that our joy may be complete.

This is the <u>message</u> we have heard from him and declare to you: God is <u>light</u>, and there is absolutely no darkness in him. If we say, "We have fellowship with him," and yet we walk in <u>darkness</u>, we are lying and are not practicing the <u>truth</u>. If we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son <u>cleanses</u> us from all sin. If we say, "We have no sin," we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we <u>confess</u> our sins, he is <u>faithful</u> and <u>righteous</u> to <u>forgive</u> us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say, "We have not <u>sinned</u>," we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. (1 John 1:1–10)
