International Missions

This lane supports projects that advance The Summit Church's global church planting and disciple-making strategy.

2025 Highlights

- · 250 people currently serving on the field
- 79 international churches planted last year
- 70 people commissioned toward Send100 goal
- 23 people in the pipeline preparing to be sent long-term
- 215 people prayerfully exploring going overseas long-term
- 175 people participating in weekly "Mission of God" class
- 13 pastors and 24 second-generation leaders in training within the Persian church

FULLY FUNDED PROJECTS

Bible Translation Project

We have partnered with illumiNations and the Museum of the Bible to fund a Bible translation in South Asia and Southeast Asia, where the people have no Bible.

Domestic Church Planting

This lane supports projects that fuel the work of planting more churches through the Summit Collaborative.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- 97 percent success rate in churches planted
- 71 churches in current collaboration to help each other plant more churches
- 55.256 in attendance for Easter 2025*
- 1,904 baptisms in the last 12 months*
- More than 2,000 college students in attendance across Collaborative churches*

FULLY FUNDED PROJECTS

Digital Bible Teaching in Prisons

Through partnerships with Department of Corrections officials and platform partners, we can offer Summit sermons on tablets inside the facilities where we serve and provide discipleship follow-up through our prison ministry volunteers.

- Pray for new families that would open their homes to support vulnerable children through foster care.
- Pray that God would raise up individuals and families that would help hold the rope for foster families, case workers, and teens aging out of foster care.

Leadership Multiplication

This lane supports projects that fuel the work of raising up, developing, and sending leaders through The Summit Church.

LANE HIGHLIGHTS

- 2,600+ kids and students participated in VBS, Kids Camp, and Student Camps
- 992 students connected weekly in small groups
- 242 students served on short-term trips
- 67 student salvations and 208 baptisms
- 1,800+ college students engaged through Summer Projects and the SC United event
- 1,000+ gospel conversations led to 170+ decisions for Christ
- 16 college students preparing for two-year international missionary service
- 184 Summit Institute graduates from 2017–2025, 85 percent serving in ministry worldwide
- 18 new graduates and 24 new apprentices and residents in 2025
- Two trips to Seminario Teológico de Santiago, advancing a partnership to equip
 Spanish-speaking churches

Growth and Expansion

This lane supports building projects that advance The Summit Church's local gospel demonstration and disciple-making strategy.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

In August 2025, the congregation voted to purchase land for the Fuquay-Varina campus—currently meeting as a mobile campus—with the purchase expected to close by the end of the year.

We transitioned our North Durham and Alamance campuses to permanent facilities and experienced significant gospel impact as evidenced by the following:

- Summit's North Durham campus (launched in 2022) and Alamance campus (launched in 2024) have both experienced remarkable growth, more than doubling in average attendance since opening.
- The Alamance campus spans 60,000 ft², with a 900-seat auditorium and Summit Kids capacity for 289 per service.
- The North Durham campus includes 38,950 ft², with a 487-seat auditorium and
 Summit Kids capacity for 174 per service.
